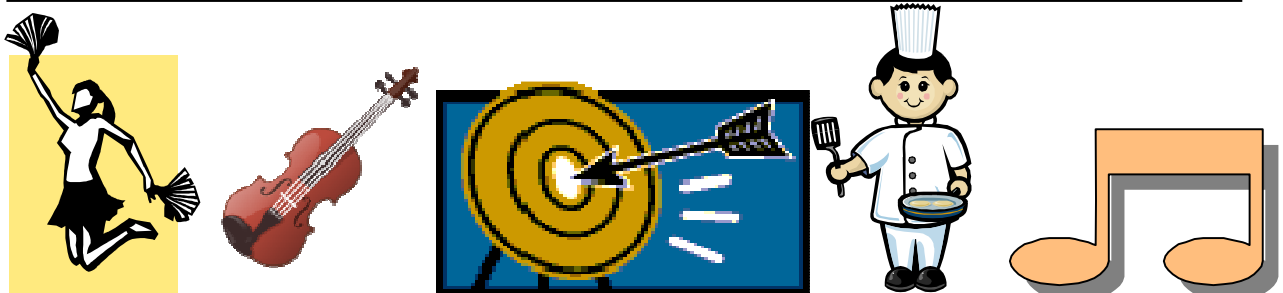

Learn how to create, record and edit music using sound software and equipment. Learn a variety of skills, such as sound recording techniques, audio sampling, multi-track recording, sequencing etc. Find out about different aspects of the recording industry!

Pupils will be able to gain a NCFE level 2 Award in Music Technology (equivalent to half a GCSE A*-C) - there may be an opportunity for some to progress to the Level 2 Certificate (equates to a full GCSE). Assessment is via the submission of a portfolio of work at the end of the year. A musical background is beneficial, but pupils need not be able to read music notation or play an instrument.
