50-70 words of your own explaining what damage acid rain is doing in Canada (try and find some data to quote)

30-50 words of your own explaining how the Canadians are trying to reduce the problem of acid rain.

Science Success Criteria:

Have they included?	check
An introduction saying what Acid Rain is and how it is caused.	
Researched information explaining what particular problems there are with Acid Rain in Canada. Make sure that you quote your references and quote actual peoples views too.	
Include any relevant data that you can find. Remember to explain who did the research if you add it in. Is it reliable?	
A paragraph about what their government and other countries governments are doing to reduce the problem in Canada.	
Their opinion on what should be done.	

Literacy Success Criteria:

Have they?	check
Used a variety of methods for setting out and conveying information (subtitles, paragraphs, sections ,boxes, tables, graphs, illustrations, bullet points)	
Used a wide range of persuasive / rhetorical devices (Use of expert opinion, facts/statistics/quotes, use of similes and metaphors)	
Used the P.E.E. structure within paragraphs (P oint : The key sentence – often at the start of the paragraph, E vidence : Facts, quotes, references to scientific sources, expert opinion etc, E xplanation : or 'Exploration' – a chance to develop the Point convincingly!)	
Included an eye-catching, appealing, colourful cover & title	
Used a variety of sentence length, e.g. short sentences for impact.	
Included scientific facts/statistics/quotes, references to scientific sources	
Made sure their spelling and punctuation is accurate	
Added a bibliography
